#### "COMING HOME!"

One of the favourable conditions that factored into the decision in 1999 to move ahead with the establishment of the Canadian Churches of Christ Historical Society was the prospect of a suitable archival setting for its collection. A leading university in southern Ontario had ambitions to become the archival center for religion in Canada. The CCCHS collection would be welcome! Six years later, in 2005, word was received that, with a change in administrative direction, the expansion of facilities would not take place and that there would not be room for our collection. Thus our hope for a central, accessible, secure, controlled, and permanent setting for our collection was dashed.

From then until recently, an ongoing effort has been made to find a suitable "home" for the society's valuable and growing collection. In the meantime storage and processing has been handled at the society's official location, 120 Moccasin Drive, Waterloo, Ontario.

Finding a location that affords the above conditions has been a top priority for the society's board, but experience has demonstrated how difficult that goal was.

Then to the rescue came Ron Knight, CCCHS vice-chairman of the board, 2005-2010. Ron and his family are developing plans to create a museum to house the eclectic collection of Ron's grandfather, Stanley Knight. The stately Meaford fire hall was purchased for this purpose. Room for the CCCHS collection was graciously offered. Security, climate control, and significant location are featured in this arrangement. The Meaford Church of Christ is in its 165<sup>th</sup> year. Some of the most important events in our Restoration history have occurred in this town. Meaford's influence has spread over all of Canada. No

The historic Meaford Fire Hall is now ready to receive and keep safe and sound our valuables. Proper shelving, correct moisture and temperature control allow us to take advantage of this wonderful gesture. It is anticipated that interested volunteers in the Meaford area will serve in caring for and providing access to our collection of papers, books, audio-visual materials, and digitized materials. No spot in Canada is more central to our Restoration past than Meaford, and we are pleased that our collection will find a permanent home there.

We thank Ron Knight for his forward thinking and usual generosity.

Then on August 18, the thirteenth annual meeting of the Canadian Churches of Christ Historical Society will be conducted at the Fire Hall in Meaford. On this occasion we will formally open the CCCHS collection in its new location. We sincerely hope that you will make the trip to one of Ontario's most scenic sites and share this significant day with us.

Speakers for the day will include:

Eugene Perry of Beamsville, Ontario.

Eugene will present his "Reminiscences" in the style of Joseph Ash. Brother Perry has lived a long time as a faithful saint and devotee of Restoration Movement history. This should prove to be very interesting to the rest of us. Eugene, reaching his 90<sup>th</sup> birthday in July, was a charter member of the CCCHS, and his collection of periodicals and other materials form the heart of the society's collection. As a preacher, educator, missionary, and long-time editor of the *Gospel Herald*, Eugene is well positioned to provide us with a valuable overview of our movement.

# Geoffrey Ellis of Waterloo, Ontario.

Geoff, who is always on the cutting edge of Restoration Movement happenings, has assembled a booklet that, in his own words, "is pretty neutral in terms of standard history with theories, evaluations, emphases, etc. But its attraction is that everyone can be become a historian in reading and analyzing the 65 years of reports and comments." The booklet, "The Disciples of Meaford, 1848-1914, Reports from the Periodicals," collects the reports and comments of various church

leaders, preachers, etc., regarding activities with the Meaford Church of Christ from the fourteen periodicals that cover the period. Geoff will introduce this work to the gathering. Copies will be available for those interested.


